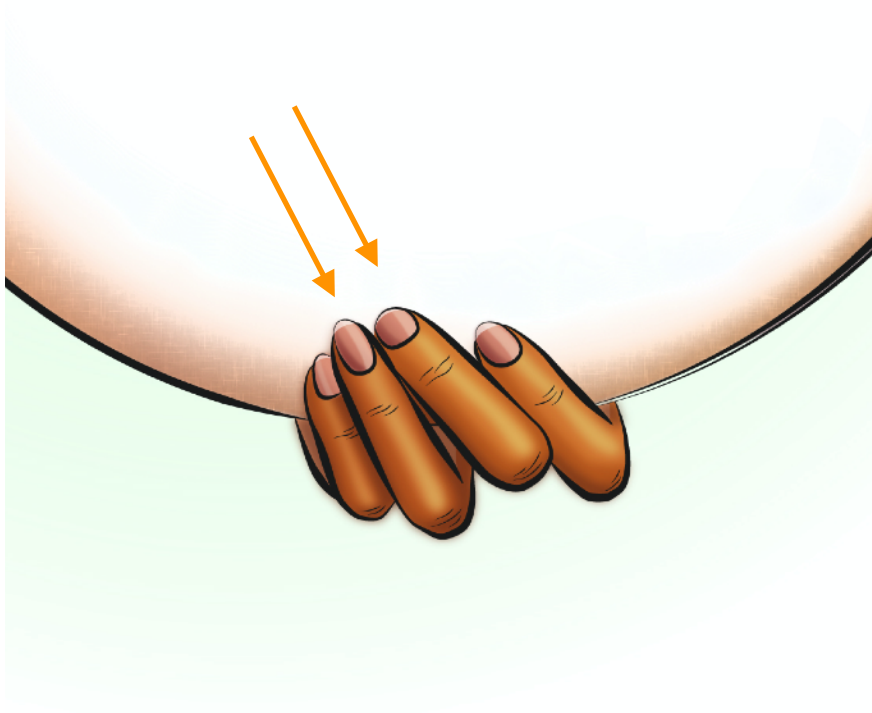


## Desert Echo Daff School: Level Two



### WHAT IS THE "AS" BEAT & HOW DO YOU PLAY IT?

The AS beat is the third main beat when playing the daff. It can also be called KA or some world drummers also refer to it as a ghost note.

The AS beat is played using the bottom middle or ring finger. It is a soft and balanced sound, neither too high or low in pitch. Initially your AS beat may be very quiet, due to lack of strength in your finger, but with practice it will become a stronger beat.

**Practice! Practice! Practice! Practice! Practice! Practice! Practice!**

Remember to practice the AS beat every day to get better at it!  
You can practice it in isolation or with the DUM and TAK beats.
